

### **Paper**

Pad of 18 x 24-inch drawing paper for charcoal Strathmore, Fabriano and other brands are all fine. You also can bring a few single sheets of toned (stick to the lighter or midtone values) if you want to try toned paper.

One newsprint pad .

### **Drawing Implements**

Choose the drawing material you are most comfortable with. You will be encouraged to try charcoal for one of the days later in the week, but for the other drawings you can choose graphite pencils such as those listed below, or sepia pencils.

Graphite pencils (grades 2H, HB, 2B)

Sepia pencils such as Conté Pastel, Conté Crayon, or Pitt Pastel

Vine charcoal (packs of soft, medium, and hard)

Nitram is an excellent brand, which can be purchased online.

Kneaded eraser

### **Other Tools**

220 grit sandpaper (several sheets) for sharpening charcoal and pencils

Artist's tape

X-Acto knife

12-inch bamboo skewer (like you get in the grocery store) or thin knitting needle to use for measuring while drawing
